MEMBERSHIP

Once the membership payment is completed, dues are paid for life and member receives a Harry Hosier Membership card, pin, and certificate .

BMCR PARTNERS \$10,000

Churches, commissions, agencies, businesses, and institutions related to The United Methodist Church are eligible to become BMCR partners, receive all BMCR publications, a certificate, and two BMCR annual meeting registrations. This membership may be paid in five consecutive yearly payments of \$2,000.

Black Methodists for Church Renewal, Inc.—BMCR—is the organized black caucus of The United Methodist Church. It represents and is dedicated to more than 2,400 black United Methodist congregations and approximately 400,000 African American members across the United States. The caucus represents persons in the general, jurisdictional and annual conferences.

The caucus has made great strides in its commitment to strengthen each local church in evangelism, worship, stewardship and outreach ministries. It has encouraged the church to support and nurture the historically black colleges and universities related to The United Methodist Church, improved educational opportunities for black youth and young adults, and strengthened black churches and the laity and clergy who serve those churches. The caucus is vital because of its:

- keen concern for the future of African Americans in the denomination,
- ability to advocate for the interests and inclusivity of blacks in the general church structures,
- unswerving efforts to motivate and inspire the black church to reach its God-given potential,
- exceptional nerve to serve as the spiritual agitating conscious of the church, and
- determination to raise up prophetic and spiritual leaders who will be advocates for the unique needs of black people in The United Methodist Church.

NATIONAL SUSTAINING MEMBERSHIP \$50

This membership is crucial because it sustains the organization during the year. It includes participation in BMCR's annual meeting with voice and vote, all BMCR publications, and a membership card. Renewable each year.

STUDENT MEMBERSHIP \$25

Undergraduates and persons enrolled in Course of Study programs at educational institutions that subscribe to BMCR's purpose may join BMCR. A student membership includes participation at the annual meeting with voice and vote, all BMCR publications, and a membership card. Renewable each year.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP \$25

United Methodists who are not of African American ancestry but who subscribe to BMCR's purpose may become an Associate Member, attend the annual meeting with voice and no vote. Includes all BMCR publications, and a membership card. Renewable each year.

CENTURY MEMBERSHIP \$750

Includes participation in BMCR's annual meeting with voice and vote, and all BMCR publications. This membership may be paid in five consecutive yearly payments of \$150. Once the membership payment is completed, dues are paid for life and member receives a Century Membership card and pin.
