WHEREAS, the confederate flag is posted and flies on the capitol grounds of South Carolina; and


WHEREAS, the presence of this flag on the capitol grounds is an affront to many African Americans of South Carolina and across the nation; and

BE IT RESOLVED, THAT BLACK METHODISTS FOR CHURCH RENEWAL, INC., REQUESTS THAT THE GOVERNOR AND STATE LEGISLATORS EXPEDITE THE REMOVAL THIS VESTIGE OF SLAVERY AND DEHUMANIZATION FROM THE CAPITOL GROUNDS OF SOUTH CAROLINA.
